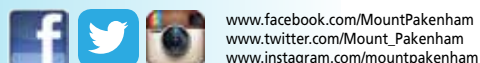

Outdoor Recreation

We can assure you our "Outdoor Recreation through Skiing, Snowboarding, and Snowshoeing" program will meet and exceed the overall and specific expectations outlined in the Health and Physical Education Curriculum. It is our policy to ensure that our programs stand behind and follow the safety guidelines set forth by your Board, the Ministry of Education, Ontario Ski Resorts Association and especially the "Physical Education Ontario Safety Guidelines" recommended by the Ontario School Boards' Insurance Exchange (OSBIE) and OPHEA (Ontario Physical Health Education Association).

Chairlift Readiness Assessment and Group Lessons

In order to ensure student safety, Mount Pakenham's certified pros assess all skiers and snowboarders to determine their ability; assign a lesson time; and grant access to ability-specific terrain. After successful completion of the assessment, students will ski/ride safely until their assigned group lesson time (beginner lesson begins right away). Students will meet for their lesson at the Snow School Meeting area where they will be assigned an instructor and given a 55 minute group lesson.

Beginner Centre Safety*Fun*Learning

Unlike traditional beginner lessons, our Station Teaching Format allows students to develop skills at their own pace. Skiers and boarders will complete up to 7 Stations with coaching from CASI and CSIA certified instructors. After successfully completing all 7 stations, the students are ready to use the chairlift independently. Students that do not complete all 7 stations can continue to practice at the Beginner Centre throughout the day. The Beginner Centre is staffed with certified pros from 9am - 2pm Monday to Friday (times may vary depending on #'s)

Designed to complement the social studies curriculum offering: snowshoeing, control style orienteering, nature trivia and a whole lot more! This program also includes a Scat & Track Trail—listen to the students giggle as they match up animal scat and tracks! Try our disc challenge on snowshoes and be sure to save time for snow tubing. This all-inclusive program will guarantee that your students will have an answer for their parents when they are asked the question: what did you learn at school today? New this year, we have a second WOW Adventure Trail for students coming for multiple snowshoe challenges.

- Rates are for organized student groups of 15 or more.
- Minimum requirement is 5 students per ability level for lessons.
- Mount Pakenham Season Pass holders pay only \$12 for the lesson.
- Teachers/Supervisors receive complementary lift tickets (max 1 per 10 paying students)*
- We recommend a minimum of 1 supervisor per 10 students to accompany school trips.
- Program is designed for ages 7+. Packages available for younger students - please call
- Special Needs students and students with significant behavioural or emotional problems can be accommodated in private lessons with a qualified instructor with advanced booking.
- We recommend 3 to 5 ski/board trips to fully benefit from the lesson progression.
- Pre-booked student private lessons available - \$45/hour 1 person (+\$15 for each additional student(s)).
- On-line Trip rosters are required 14 days in advance or you may be subject to cancellation or rescheduling. Rosters allow us to pre-set rental equipment which maximizes your time on slopes.
- Night group lessons are for beginners only and are offered at 4:00, 5:00 or 6:00 Tuesday to Friday.
- Night Chairlift Readiness Assessment option available to night students that are not taking lessons for a \$1 student charge.
- Personal Equipment must meet safety standards. Metal edges and braking devices are mandatory. Helmets must be ski or snowboard type and are included with rental equipment.
- Fund Raising-we can help! Ask us about our tailor made fundraising program.
- Schools are eligible for a refund of 83% of HST paid.

* school supervisors must be competent skiers, supervisors must accompany students on snowshoe trails.
