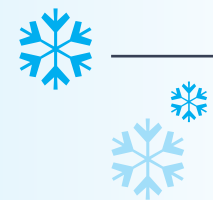


Attention High School Teachers and Students

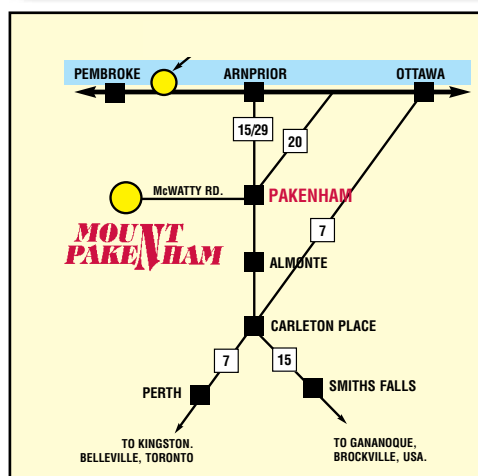
STUDENT SUCCESS AND POST SECONDARY EDUCATION

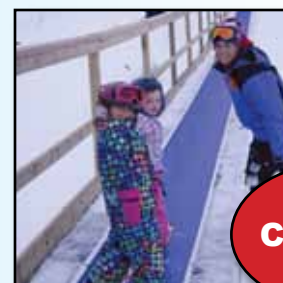
RESERVE EARLY

Designed to complement the social studies curriculum offering; snowshoeing, control style orienteering, nature trivia and a whole lot more! This program also includes a Scat & Track Trail—listen to the students giggle as they match up animal scat and tracks to de-code a word! Test out our New Frisbee Golf Course on snowshoes and be sure to save time for skating and snow tubing. This all-inclusive program will guarantee that your students will have an answer for their parents when they are asked the question: what did you learn at school today?

Outdoor Recreation

We can assure you our "Outdoor Recreation through Skiing, Snowboarding, and Snowshoeing" program will meet and exceed the overall and specific expectations outlined in the Health and Physical Education Curriculum. It is our policy to ensure that our programs stand behind and follow the safety guidelines set forth by your Board, the Ministry of Education, Ontario Ski Resorts Association and especially the "Physical Education Ontario Safety Guidelines" recommended by the Ontario School Boards' Insurance Exchange (OSBIE).

Chairlift Readiness Assessment and Group Lessons

In order to ensure student safety, Mount Pakenham's certified pros assess all skiers and snowboarders to determine their ability; assign a lesson time; and grant access to ability-specific terrain. After successful completion of the assessment, students will ski/ride safely until their assigned group lesson time (beginner lesson begins right away). Students will meet for their lesson at the Snow School Meeting area where they will be assigned an instructor and given a 55 minute group lesson.

Beginner Centre Safety*Fun*Learning

Unlike traditional beginner lessons, our Station Teaching Format allows students to develop skills at their own pace. Skiers and boarders will complete up to 7 Stations with coaching from CASI and CSIA certified instructors. After completing all 7 stations, the students are ready to use the chairlift independently. Students that do not complete all 7 stations can continue to practice at the Beginner Centre throughout the day. The Beginner Centre is staffed with certified pros from 9am-12pm and from 1pm to 2pm Monday to Friday (times may vary depending on #'s)

Fun alternatives or additions to your winter outing:

Tubing \$10/student
in our new tubing area- students earn their fun with a short hike up and an exhilarating slide down. (Minimum 30 Tubers)

Winter Outdoor Wonder (WOW) \$15/student \$14 /student (no tubing)
An introduction to winter wilderness in eastern Canada. Students use our snowshoes to walk our Discovery Nature Trail and learn interesting facts about wildlife, birds and outdoor winter survival. This program also includes use of our tube park and skating rink (bring your own skates). (Minimum 10 participants) snowshoes included in WOW pricing

Both our Tubing program and our new WOW program are designed to meet Ontario's physical education curriculum standards.



Additional Information and Fine Print



- Rates are for school groups of 15 or more.
- Minimum requirement is 5 students per ability level for lessons.
- Mount Pakenham Season Pass holders pay only \$11 for the lesson.
- Teachers/Supervisors receive complementary lift tickets (max 2 per 10 paying students)
- We recommend a minimum of 1 supervisor per 10 students to accompany school trips.
- Program is designed for ages 7+. Packages available for younger students - please call
- Special Needs students and students with significant behavioural or emotional problems can be accommodated in private lessons with a qualified instructor with advanced booking.
- We recommend 3 to 5 ski/board trips to fully benefit from the lesson progression.
- Pre-booked student private lessons available - \$35/hour 1 person \$45/hour 2-3 people.
- On-line Trip rosters are required 14 days in advance or you may be subject to cancellation or rescheduling. Late rosters are subject to a \$30 surcharge.
- Night lessons are for beginners only and are offered at 4:30 or 5:30 Tuesday to Friday.
- Night Chairlift Readiness Assessment option available to night students that are not taking lessons for a \$1/student charge.
- Personal Equipment must meet safety standards. Metal edges and braking devices are mandatory. Helmets must be ski or snowboard type.
